

The contract between volunteer and 4th Baltic Jamboree's organizers Nr. _____

Latvian Scout and Guide central organization (in text LSGCO), legal entity by Latvian Law, reg. nr. 40008000437, legal representative, Chair of the Board Agnija Jansone (form one side) and

Name of the volunteer (VOLUNTEER in the following text) from other side, agrees:

1. LSGCO is organizing a camp – the 4th Baltic Scout and Guide Jamboree “THE JUMP” (the CAMP in the following text) - from 07.07.2019 till 13.07.2019., (including preparation and cleaning up camp from 05.07.2019.-14.07.2019.) at “Ezernieki”, Indrani, Lubanas area, Latvia.
2. The volunteer, by expressing his or her free will, agrees to work for LSGCO and to carry out planning, organizational and practical work to ensure the implementation of scout method, development of scouting and guiding.
3. The volunteer agrees take his/her's duties form __ .07.2019. – 14.07.2019.
4. Volunteering is organized in accordance with the Voluntary Service Act, the Statutes of LSGCO and general principles of scouting and guiding.
5. The Volunteer undertakes:
 - 5.1. to work in a volunteer working group - preparation and implementation of the CAMP;
 - 5.2. to observe the camp rules, labour protection, safety equipment and work hygiene requirements, to treat the property used during the camp with care;
 - 5.3. to carry out a personal record of volunteering, indicating the hours worked, hours and activity;
 - 5.4. to execute the assigned tasks within the set time limits;
 - 5.5. to sure that volunteering does not interfere with or influence the volunteer school or work visit.
6. The volunteer assumes full material responsibility for the money, material and other values transferred to him/her by LSGCO and for which the volunteer systematically reports.
7. LSGCO undertakes:
 - 7.1. to provide the Volunteer with the workplace and suitable working conditions in accordance with the defined CAMP rules or LSGCO internal procedures;
 - 7.2. to introduce the Volunteer with the work and circumstances to be performed, internal procedures and other regulations;
 - 7.3. to provide education and training opportunities;
 - 7.4. to ensure the acquisition of experience and accounting of acquired competences.
8. The Costs associated with volunteering are refunded upon prior approval;
9. In the course of volunteering, the VOLUNTEER follows the following rules:
 - 9.1. to arrive in time and participates in activities organized by LSGCO;
 - 9.2. To inform LSGCO in a timely manner, if the VOLUNTEER may not participate in achieving assigned task;
 - 9.3. To follow instructions of the camp chief and heads of the camps organizational aread;
10. The use of alcohol, narcotic and other intoxicating substances in LSGCO activities is strictly prohibited.
11. THE VOLUNTEER is aware that during organized activities it is possible to photograph and film and agree to the use of the material and photos to popularize the organization at events. All copyrights belong to the organizers.
12. IF The VOLUNTEER, for various reasons, cannot continue its work at the event, the VOLUNTEER shall inform the LSGCO as soon as possible.
13. The volunteer may receive LSGCO's certification of the work to be performed, the number of hours to be performed, the character of the volunteer, and the skills and abilities acquired.
14. The volunteer may receive LSGCO's recommendations for the work performed, indicating the experience, characteristics and skills of the volunteer.

15. LSGCO shall not be liable for personal financial loss resulting from the VOLUNTARY ACTION or inaction.
16. VOLUNTARY shall be liable for moral damage and / or financial loss caused by LSGCO as a result of its actions or omissions.
17. VOLUNTARY OPERATION or mission, which is offensive to LSGCO's honor and dignity, may be considered as a cause of VOLUNTARY exclusion from future activities organized or coordinated by LSGCO.
18. Mutual correspondence shall be carried out electronically using THE CAMPS team emails, personal e-mails, correspondence on the Internet website Facebook or separately by telephone.
19. The AGREEMENT may be changed by mutual written agreement. THE AGREEMENT is drawn up in Latvian in 2 (two) copies, one for each PARTY.
20. All disputes arising from this AGREEMENT shall be settled by mutual negotiations.
21. LSGCO shall not be liable for personal financial loss resulting from the VOLUNTARY ACTION or inaction.
