

INTERNAL ORGANIZATION AND SECURITY PROVISIONS

4. "Baltic Scouts and Guides Camp "The Jump"

1. CAMP RULES AND SCOUTS AND GUIDES LAWS *.

- 1) Scout / guide is true
 - 2) Scout / guide is faithful to the Fatherland
 - 3) Scout / guide is selfless and helpful
 - 4) Scout / guide is friendly and tolerant
 - 5) Scout / guide is polite
 - 6) Scout / guide is a nature friend
 - 7) Scout / guide is obedient
 - 8) Scout / guide is lively in difficulty
 - 9) Scout / guide is active and thrifty
 - 10) Scout / guide is clean in thoughts, words and deeds
2. Camp regulations must be observed by all camp participants, staff and guests.
 3. All camp participants and the current agenda must be followed.
 4. During the camp, all instructions and orders of the camp leaders must be observed - both during and outside the camp.
 5. It is prohibited to build constructions and structures in the camp territory that are not coordinated with the camp leaders.
 6. Camp building and harvesting works shall be in accordance with the instructions and orders of the camp leaders.
 7. Without the leader's permission, it is strictly forbidden to leave the camp area.
 8. Use and being under the influence of alcohol, drugs and psychotropic substances are prohibited during the camp. Smoking is prohibited for anyone under the age of 18 and is permitted only in designated areas during the free time.
 9. It is forbidden to use music sound equipment in the camp territory, except when it is agreed with the camp commandant.
 10. Only those who have reached the age of 18 may use axes independently. Minors can only use axes only with leader's permission and their immediate vicinity. The axes cannot be used in the dark hours of the day.
 11. Carefully use sharp objects carefully to avoid crossing yourself or others.
 12. Trees can only be cut down where shown by leader or commandant.
 13. Without the permission of the camp management, there must be no participants near open water.
 14. Comply with all fire regulations.
 15. In case of health and individual problems, contact one of the camp leaders. Follow the instructions of the camp medic and leaders.

- 16.** If emergency assistance is required and there are no adults in the vicinity (serious injury, fire, etc.), call the specialists of the relevant service immediately (CALLING 112) and/or use the telephone numbers attached to the info board.
- 17.** The night sleep of the camp is between 00:00 and 8:00, and everyone has to keep quiet. During the night there will be a night guard at the camp.
- 18.** Follow road operations by moving along populated areas and roads. In the dark time of the day, it is imperative to wear a reflective vest.
- 19.** Treat the environment gently and the equipment in the area of the camp.
- 20.** Do not follow strangers (not members of the camp), do not pet unknown animals, do not eat unknown plants.
- 21.** Comply with personal hygiene, cleanliness and order (including hand washing before meals, after toilet visits, etc.)
- 22.** Keep track of your personal belongings and the environment during the camp.
- 23.** Care and cleanliness should be observed at campsite facilities, water abstraction and waste collection sites.
- 24.** Do not deliberately cause physical and moral damage to camp participants and leaders.
- 25.** Respect the opinions, interests and personal affairs of other participants in the camp.
- 26.** In case of camp evacuation follow the evacuation plan and direct instructions of the camp leaders.
- 27.** Don't take fast food or food, that perish quickly with you at the camp. Chips, sugared lemonades, energy drinks are forbidden! If You have snacks, please share them with others.
- 28.** Any precious metals, jewels, portable Computers, GPS, etc. valuables are NOT recommended to take along. Camp organizers are not responsible for these items!

SWIMMING RULES:

1. Bathing shall take place under the strict supervision of the drivers, in due time;
2. At the same time, no more than 10 camp participants may be present in the water, except where the bathing officer has determined a different number;
3. strictly follow the instructions given by the leaders;
4. It is prohibited to swim beyond the authorized area;
5. It is forbidden to deliberately physically injure, annoy and harm other participants of the camp during bathing, depicting drowning, diving, and jumping in the water.
6. It is forbidden to intentionally mislead leaders with false alarms;
7. It is prohibited to swim alone. Swim is only allowed if there is an adult in the water;
8. Get out of the water immediately after the driver signal. In case of trauma, seek immediate medical advice from the camp.

FIRE SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Only campfires that are coordinated with the camp commandant and in the presence of the leader may be fired in the camp territory.
2. Make sure that there is either a functioning fire extinguisher or a bucket of water or sand next to the fire.
3. It is forbidden to bring in or use any kind of flames, smoldering objects (candles, trannies, deodorants, incense etc.) in tents.
4. The fireplace shall be constructed in a mound, at least 20 cm above the ground or buried, encircled by turf and / or stones.
5. It is prohibited to burn household waste in the camp territory.

IN CASE OF FIRE:

1. Every camp participant must immediately notify the camp management of the fire.
2. The camp management will immediately notify the fire service by telephone 112.
3. Each member of the camp must do everything in his power to prevent the spread of the fire.
4. All adult leaders should take care of informing the camp participants about evacuation measures and future action.
